## THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND CIVIC EDUCATION

### HEREBY ANNOUNCES THE FOLLOWING:

As part of the operationalisation of the Youth Conneckt Cameroon Programme, launched in December 2019, under the Very High Patronage of the Head of State H.E. Paul BIYA, and with the aim of improving the employability of young graduates through their professional immersion. a call for applications is launched for the selection and deployment in internship of 170 young men and women trained or being trained, in the services of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Civic Education and in some partner structures, for a period of two to three months.

### CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED

All young cameroonian men and women, aged between 15 and 35, who wish to undertake an academic or professional internship, holders of a vocational training diploma or who are duly enrolled in an academic or vocational training structure, may apply.

## II. COMPOSITION OF THE APPLICATION FILE

All application files should include the following documents:

- a handwritten stamped application addressed to the Minister of Youth Affairs and Civic Education ;
- an application form to be collected from the MINJEC mail service, at the level of its regional, divisional and sub-divisional delegations, or downloaded from the MINJEC website (www.minjec.gov.cm) and that of the National Youth Observatory (www.onjcameroun.cm).
- a photocopy of the birth certificate;
- a photocopy of the national identity card;
- a photocopy of the student card;
- a photocopy of the professional diploma or a valid school certificate;
- a photocopy of the registration attestation in the National Youth Observatory.

## III. DEADLINE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FILES

Application files shall be received in a sealed envelope at the Mail Service of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Civic Education, located at the Administrative Centre, or in Regional and Divisional Delegations of MINJEC, no later than Friday, 09 July 2021 at 3.30 p.m., with the words: "FOR THE 2021 SELECTION OF YOUNG PEOPLE FOR THEIR ACADEMIC AND PROFESSIONAL INTERNSHIPS AS PART OF THE YOUTH CONNECT CAMEROON", or through the Email address: minjecdpej@gmail.com.
